The 3-ring circuses known as the Republican National Convention and the Democratic National Convention are now history, thank God! As the entire universe holds its breath waiting for November 8th, the Usual Suspects bang the drum for Hillary Clinton, for whom, according to Bernie Sanders supporters, the Democratic National Committee had to hire seat-fillers to pack Philadelphia's Wells Fargo Arena.

Anyhoo, before Her Majesty accepted the nomination (which was - surprise! - rigged by the DNC against Sanders from the jump), Mr. and Mrs. Khizr Khan, whose son, Army Captain Humayun Khan, was killed in Iraq in 2004, were trotted out to serve up a bit of Kabuki theater. Below is what Khan, an attorney, told the delegates:

Tonight we are honored to stand here as parents of Captain Humayun Khan and as patriotic American Muslims - with undivided loyalty to our country. Like many immigrants, we came to this country empty-handed. We believed in American democracy; that with hard work and goodness of this country, we could share in and contribute to its blessings. We are blessed to raise our three sons in a nation where they were free to be themselves and follow their dreams. Our son, Humayun, had dreams too, of being a military lawyer, but he put those dreams aside the day he sacrificed his life to save the lives of his fellow soldiers. Hillary Clinton was right when she called my son "the best of America".

If it was up to Donald Trump, he never would have been in America. Donald Trump consistently smears the character of Muslims. He disrespects other minorities; women; judges; even his own party leadership. He vows to build walls, and ban us from this country. Donald Trump, you're asking Americans to trust you with their future. Let me ask you: have you even read the United States Constitution? I will gladly lend you my copy. In this document, look for the words "liberty" and "equal protection of law".

Have you ever been to Arlington Cemetery? Go look at the graves of brave patriots who died defending the United States of America. You will see all faiths, genders, and ethnicities. You have sacrificed nothing and no one. We cannot solve our problems by building walls, sowing division. We are stronger together. And we will keep getting stronger when Hillary Clinton becomes our President.

In conclusion, I ask every patriot American, all Muslim immigrants, and all immigrants to not take this election lightly. This is a historic election, and I request to honor the sacrifice of my son, and on election day, take the time to get out and vote. And vote for the healer, vote for the strongest, most qualified candidate, Hillary Clinton, not the divider.

Allow me a moment to puke at the DemocRATS using these poor people to wrap themselves in the document they have been shitting on for the past 7 1/2 years! Allow me also to point out the blatant double-standard. After Patricia Smith, mother of Sean Smith, who was killed in Benghazi, spoke at the RNC, *PolitiFact* fact-checked her claims, and *Vox* deemed her appearance "a bit exploitative and, at the same time, irrelevant". MSNBC's Chris Matthews: "I don't care what that woman up there, the mother, has felt. Her emotions are her own. But for the country in choosing a leader, it's wrong to have someone get up there and tell a lie about Hillary Clinton." And the Twitter-verse piled on Pakistan-born entrepreneur Sajid Tarar, who gave the closing prayer at the RNC, and quoted Muhammad. Just how wacko are these Moonbats? Retired general John Allen and Medal of Honor winner Florent Groberg were heckled by Sanders delegates!

The RNC exploited Mrs. Smith, just as the DNC exploited Mr. and Mrs. Khan. The real issue is the how and the why. More to the point, Trump had nothing to do with Captain Khan's death; Clinton had everything to do with Smith's death.

After giving Matthews and his fellow Moonbats a collective orgasm, Kahn made the Sunday morning talk show rounds. On CNN's "*State of the Union*", he said the world has "seen the blackness of [Trump's] character, of his soul", then tripled-down:

... there was in the speech that my good wife asked me to refrain from saying, I wanted to say we reject all violence. We are faithful, patriotic, undivided loyalty to this country. We reject all terrorism. She asked me not to say that because that was not the occasion for such a statement. We say to his ignorance, I address his ignorance, that the dirt effect, the most effect of the menace of terrorism have been Muslims in the world, Muslims hate this menace of terrorism as much as any other place. It is our duty to keep this country, our country, beautiful country, safe. We have always thought of [it] that way, we will continue to do our part to keep it safe and beautiful. What he cites in the name of Islam, and all that — that is not Islam at all! I wish he would have, somebody would have put something in his head that these are terrorists, these are criminals, these folks have nothing to do with Islam.

Get that? Khan defended his refusal to denounce Islamic terrorism by throwing his good wife under the bus! What was that about "blackness of character", again?

Speaking of Mrs. Khan, she is also making the most of her 15 minutes. In an op-ed for <u>The Washington Post</u>, she said she didn't speak at the convention: "Because without saying a thing, all the world, all America, felt my pain".

Not surprisingly, The Khan Job was sweet music to the ears of our old pal, Rod Dreher of <u>The American Conservative</u>, who fired off a blurb he entitled "Gold Star Father Clobbers Tin Pot Politician": "Whatever your beliefs on Muslim immigration are, you cannot deny the reality of the Khan family's immense sacrifice for this country, and it is indecent to try". Commenting on Trump's speculation to ABC's George Stephanopoulos on why Mrs. Khan didn't speak and if Khan wrote his speech, Dreher ranted:

The man is contemptible. For the record, he never served in Vietnam, having received a student deferment to complete his Ivy League business degree, and later a medical deferment, supposedly over bone spurs in his feet. He lied to the press about his deferment status... It's not even August. Can you imagine what else is going to come out of Trump's mouth before November? It would have been so very easy to have compassionately deflected Khizr Khan's criticism. But that's not how Donald Trump rolls. He sure is making it easy for people who fear or loathe Hillary Clinton to withhold their votes from him.

For the record, Trump was classified 1-Y in October 1968, meaning he would only have been drafted were there a national emergency. The REAL reason Dreher and the media finds Trump's remarks "contemptible" is because Trump inferred an inconvenient truth: under Islam, women are expected to be subservient. Fact!

I have even-worse news for Dreher: if the dozens of responses on Yahoo! to Khan's remarks are any indication, the Trump Train isn't going off the rails any time soon:

* @michael: Khan's son made the sacrifice, not Khan himself. He lost a son, and that is an awful thing for any parent to experience. However, characterizing Khan as the martyr in this is a dishonest shell game, and needs to be called out for what it is. Absolutely shameful Democrats. Your corrupt despicable practices betray your true nature.

The president in 1980, Jimmy Carter, banned Shiites and Sunnis from entry during the hostage crisis, and had Iranian students deported. He was exercising his authority to protect the country (8 U.S.C. § 1182(f)). No one called Carter a racist or Islamophobic. The liberty and equal protection Khan speaks of does not apply to non-citizens (you would think an attorney would know THAT!) And it sure as hell does not apply to those who want to wipe us off the face of the Earth!

In the 56 countries where Islam is the dominate faith, women have no property rights, their testimony in only worth one-half that of men, they need 5 male relatives to corroborate a rape or risk being stoned to death for adultery, and 1 in 5 Muslim women have undergone genital mutilation! Instead of condemning the barbarism responsible for his son's death, Khan vented at a man who opposed the conflict his son was sent to fight!

Back to Khan's insidiously deceitful claim that Islam has nothing to do with terrorism. Does honor killing have anything to do with Islam? Does forcing underage girls into marriage have anything to do with Islam? Does forced conversion have anything to do with Islam? Does slavery have anything to do with Islam? Does killing those who practice homosexuality have anything to do with Islam? Does female circumcision have anything to do with Islam? Do eggs have anything to do with omelets? Just asking. As to Khan's truly insipid claim that Trump smears the character of Muslims, Muslims do that all by themselves, thank you very much, and will continue to do so until jihad is declared on jihad.

From 1998-2007, he was manager of Litigation Technology Services for law firm Hogan & Hartson, which was on retainer to the Saudi government and a top bundler for both the Democratic Party and the Clintons. One of the lawyers at Hogan & Hartson at the time was future Attorney General Loretta Lynch. There is no evidence Khan had any role in the shenanigans at Hogan & Hartson, and his former boss praised him as a man of character. However, there is no denying his ties to the Clintons and their high-powered pals.

His New York-based practice specializes in E2 Treaty Investors and EB5 Investments. E2 and EB5 are federal programs designed to provide foreigners the right of residence and citizenship in exchange for business capital. In other words, Khan is a human trafficker. But instead of smuggling penniless people into the country, he rolls out the welcome mat for those who can pony-up at least \$500,000. Not surprisingly, the visas-for-sale business is a cesspool of fraud and corruption, as the 7/14/14 *Fortune* noted.

The phone number listed for his law office is for Chesapeake, Virginia-based American Muslims Vote. Its mission: "To create an enlightened community by providing and developing Patriotic American Muslim leadership and encouraging American Muslims to participate in the democratic process at local, state and national level and vote on the election day". Khan registered its domain name 5 days before the convention opened.

He wrote a review of a pamphlet of a seminar held in Kuwait, "Human Rights in Islam" [*Texas International Law Journal* (18:293; 239-40)], praising an address by Allah Bukhsh Karim Bukhsh Brohi, in which Brohi condones killing and mutilating those who violate Sharia, and for men to beat their wives for acting "unseemly". Brohi was an advisor to Pakistani dictator Muhammad Zia-ul-Haq, co-founder of the Taliban. Khan agrees with Brohi's contention that human rights can be guaranteed only through the establishment of Sharia.

In "Juristic Classification of Islamic Law" [<u>Houston Journal of International Law</u> (6:23 pp. 24-35)], Khan cites as one of his sources the writings of Said Ramadan, a leader of the Muslim Brotherhood and son-in-law of its founder, Hassan Al-Banna. "Allah is our objective; the Qur'an is the Constitution; the Prophet is our leader; jihad is our way; death for the sake of Allah is our wish" is one of its mottos. In the piece, he explains the importance of Sharia interpretation to followers of Islam:

The present form of the Qur'an is one and the same in every part of the Muslim world, and it has been so all through the centuries. This, Muslims believe, is due to the fact that the compilation and arrangement of chapters was completed-under divine instructions-by the Prophet himself... [due to this] to Muslims, the Qur'an being the very word of God, it is the absolute authority from which springs the very conception of legality and every legal obligation.

Get that? MUSLIMS MUST PLACE SHARIA ABOVE ALL FORMS OF GOVERNANCE! Despite his pledges of patriotism, Kahn IS, first and foremost, a practicing Muslim, so he MUST place Sharia above the Constitution he took an oath to uphold as an attorney, which makes the stunt he pulled at the DNC all the more-despicable AND makes his son an apostate under Sharia for helping Christians kill Muslims. And he had the gall to tell CNN's Anderson Cooper: "I do not stand for any sharia law because there is no such thing!"

Khan's stunt was NO spontaneous display, as a piece he co-wrote for the 9/12/05 <u>American Lawyer Media's Legal Times</u> titled "Jurors, Watch the Screen" makes clear. He and the Democrat elite sees Trump as a huge threat to their access to wealthy Middle Easterners. Now you know why the coordinated pile-on. Now you know why Kahn told CNN Monday: "We want to be out of this controversy", then took his law firm's website down (he told Cooper he shut the website down on the advice of the site's host).

The irony of Khan's declaration that Trump has sacrificed nothing is lost completely on him. "The healer" he vouches for has sacrificed nothing, her husband has sacrificed nothing, their daughter has sacrificed nothing, and the current president - who released 5 of Guantanamo Bay's "finest" in exchange for a traitor, and flies radicals in by the plane-load, putting every American in harm's way - has sacrificed nothing!

The only ones who know the true meaning of the word "sacrifice" are the young men and women who wore the uniform, here no longer.
