## [January 24, 2016]

Entering my 53<sup>rd</sup> year, I have been forced to reconcile myself with several harsh truths. I will never win Wimbledon. I will never win an Olympic gold medal. And, seeing how well my "career" has been chugging along, it's a pretty safe bet that I will never win an Academy Award. Now, I don't want to.

Exactly one week after a bunch of blowhards accused it of being racist, sexist, homophobic, xenophobic boobs, because, for the second straight year, all of the acting nominees are - horror of horrors! - white, the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences Board of Governors at an emergency meeting on January 21<sup>st</sup> approved sweeping changes to its voting rules in the high-unholy name of diversity:

"Each new member's voting status will last 10 years, and will be renewed if [he or she] has been active in motion pictures during that decade. Members will receive lifetime voting rights after three ten-year terms; or if they have won or been nominated... We will apply these standards retroactively to current members".

No one noticed the nominees were white until Academy president Cheryl Boone Isaacs - who, apparently, has never met a white person she didn't think was a racist, sexist, homophobic, xenophobic boob - threw the organization she presides over under the bus: "While we celebrate [the nominees'] extraordinary achievements, I am both heartbroken and frustrated about the lack of inclusion". And that the Best Director winner 6 years ago was a woman (albeit, a white one). Did the racist, sexist, homophobic, xenophobic boobs elect Isaacs president because she is black AND a woman? Just curious.

Will Smith said he won't attend the Oscars after his wife, Jada Pinkett-Smith, and director Spike Lee called for a boycott, joined by William H. Macy, and Michael Moore. "Saturday Night Live" did a skit in which the Best Actor winner was "all the white guys". The way the bunch of blowhards are carrying on, you'd think this was the greatest crime against humanity since the designated hitter:

\* Halle Berry: "I believed... [when she won in 2002]... this was going to incite change... that another woman of color has not [won] is heartbreaking".

- \* Don Cheadle: "I want [Oscar host Chris Rock] to take everybody to task over this".
- \* George Clooney: "... the industry isn't representing [blacks] well enough... For Hispanics, it's even worse. We need to get better at this".
- \* Matt Damon: "We're talking about huge systemic injustices... in our industry and in our country".
- \* Viola Davis: "You could probably line up all the A-list black actresses out there and they probably don't make what one A-list white woman makes in one film... It's a symptom of a much greater disease".
- \* Danny DeVito: "We're a bunch of racists".
- \* David Ehrich, <u>Rolling Stone</u>: "If [actor Michael B.] Jordan really wanted a nomination, maybe he shouldn't have been born black -- that's just poor Oscar strategizing".
- \* Dustin Hoffman: "In our country, there's a subliminal racism... The end of the Civil War didn't change that".
- \* Ian McKellen: "No openly-gay man has ever won the Oscar. I wonder if that is prejudice or chance".
- \* Lupita Nyong'o: "It has me thinking about unconscious prejudice and what merits prestige in our culture".
- \* David Oyelowo: "For 20 opportunities to celebrate actors of color... for that to happen again... is unforgivable".
- \* Mark Ruffalo: "The entire American system is rife with white privilege racism".
- \* Marlon Wayans: "It's called the 'Oscars'. It's named after a white dude. It's not as if it's called the 'Jamals' or the 'Leroys'".
- \* Reese Witherspoon: "I would love to see a more-diverse voting membership".

Race-shaming isn't limited to the film industry, of course. Rapper Macklemore, who made a splash with his pro-gay/anti-Christian screed "Same Love", is being flayed over his I-am-So-Sorry-I-Was-Born-White opus, "White Privilege II". The white male-owned sports media's stock-in-trade is accusing white male athletes, white male team owners, white male-run

leagues, and white male fans of being racist, sexist, homophobic, xenophobic boobs. And if I had a dime for every time have I read or heard that Trump is a racist, sexist, homophobic, xenophobic boob, I'd be richer than Trump!

- \* Mark Reina: "I am a gay man and my father is a Latino immigrant. Please explain to me how denying me my right to vote makes the Academy... more diverse?".
- \* Steven Spielberg: "I don't believe that there is inherent or dormant racism because of the amount of white Academy members. I'm also not 100% sure that taking votes away from Academy members who have paid their dues... to strip their votes? I'm not 100% behind that... it starts on the page... we all have to be more proactive in... just seeking talent".
- \* Stephen Verona: "Try telling the NBA to hire more white, Latino, Chinese or Eskimo basketball players and see the backlash... why doesn't Spike Lee return his honorary Oscar if he's so incensed?".
- \* John Van Vliet: "Since nominations for acting come from the actors... [they] either felt there were no performances by 'diverse people' worthy... or they are all unabashed racists... It's a... ritual killing of the members who have the least pull... the least able to defend themselves... you should be ashamed of yourselves".

Most aren't this courageous, insane as that sounds. Charlotte Rampling issued an apology after telling Europe 1 that calls for a boycott is "racist to whites". Julie Delpy also begged forgiveness after telling *The Wrap*: "I said something about the Academy being very white male, and I was slashed to pieces... I sometimes wish I were African-American because people don't bash them afterward".

So how will Isaacs's "Boob" New World work? Will white members be pressured to vote for blacks? Will black members be pressured to vote for Asians? Will the members recruited in the high-holy name of diversity be pressured to vote for "diverse people"? And what will happen to these recruits should they fail to snag an Oscar nod? Instituting changes without allowing membership a say is flat-out tyranny, but Directors Guild of America president Paris Barclay - whose organization in 1999, without consulting its membership, announced it would rename its D.W. Griffith Award, as it decided Griffith "helped foster intolerable racial stereotypes" - doesn't think Isaacs is being tyrannical enough: "The Academy's decisions... will do little to... reflect the diversity we all deserve".
